YOUNG GEORGIA AUTHORS WRITING COMPETITION

The purpose of this statewide competition, sponsored by the Georgia Department of Education, is to encourage students to develop enthusiasm for—and expertise in—their writing; to provide a context to celebrate their writing successes; and to recognize student achievement in the arts and academics.

You may submit a maximum of TWO entries; each requires a separate completed entry form.

Bring your entry AND parent-signed completed application on the back of this document to your ELA teacher, Mr. Custar, or the front office by 4:15pm on Thursday, February 6th!

WHAT TO WRITE

Unlike many writing competitions, the YGA does not provide a prompt to which students must respond. **NOTE: Students may submit a maximum of TWO entries.** These are the only criteria for entry:

- 1. The entry you submit must be **yours alone**: it must be wholly your own work, without the help of others and without collaborative effort.
- 2. Your submission must be 1900 words or fewer.
- 3. You'll need to follow a few key formatting protocols. Please see below for FORMATTING RULES.

Entries may include:

- Short stories
- Poetry
- Essays
- Literary criticism / analysis

- Journalism
- Academic writing
- Research reports
- Personal narratives
- Dramatic writing

 Any other type of original student writing!

FORMATTING RULES

- 1. Your entry must be typed in a standard font (Times New Roman or similar)
- 2. Prose writings (non-drama, non-poetry) should be **double-spaced**
- 3. Your entry should be **printed single-sided**
- 4. Neither your name nor the name of our school should be included in your entry
- 5. Make sure to **staple a completed entry form** to each individual submission
- 6. Aside from that one staple, <u>do not bind</u>, <u>make a cover for</u>, <u>decorate</u>, <u>laminate</u>, <u>or otherwise alter the original paper</u> on which the entry is written.

NOTE: The physical entry you submit will NOT be returned to you!

SCORING

Your work will be evaluated by a team of ELA teachers here at Innovation Academy using criteria set forth by the state (expression of ideas, language use, and unique perspective/voice); one winning entry per grade level will advance to the county competition, and the winning works at that level will go on to the final state round. Contact Mr. Custar if you'd like more specific information regarding scoring. School-level winners will be announced on Teams by February 20th.

Scores will NOT be disclosed to anyone outside the scoring team.
