These students live in Tanzania, where the opportunity for STEM learning is very rare. Over the summer the IA Outreach team partnered with UBORA, who has worked in the school system in Tanzania for the last 20 years. The IA Outreach team led a weeklong STEM camp at a primary school which was the student's first introduction to STEM. I am excited to share that a STEM-focused high school is being built through this partnership. Like IA, they will have three designated pathways for the students to choose from to grow their skills in agribusiness, mechatronics, and computer science. The impact of this school will be profound as they prioritize raising up servant leaders that will have lasting impacts on their families and communities, as I hope you have had a similar experience here at IA.
