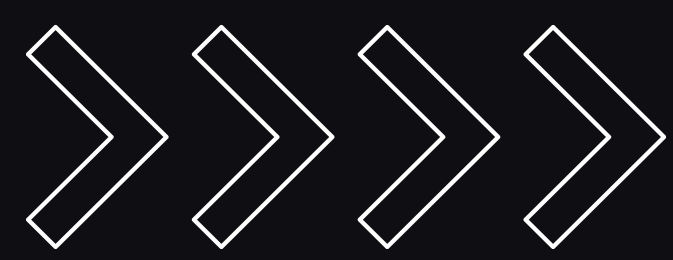

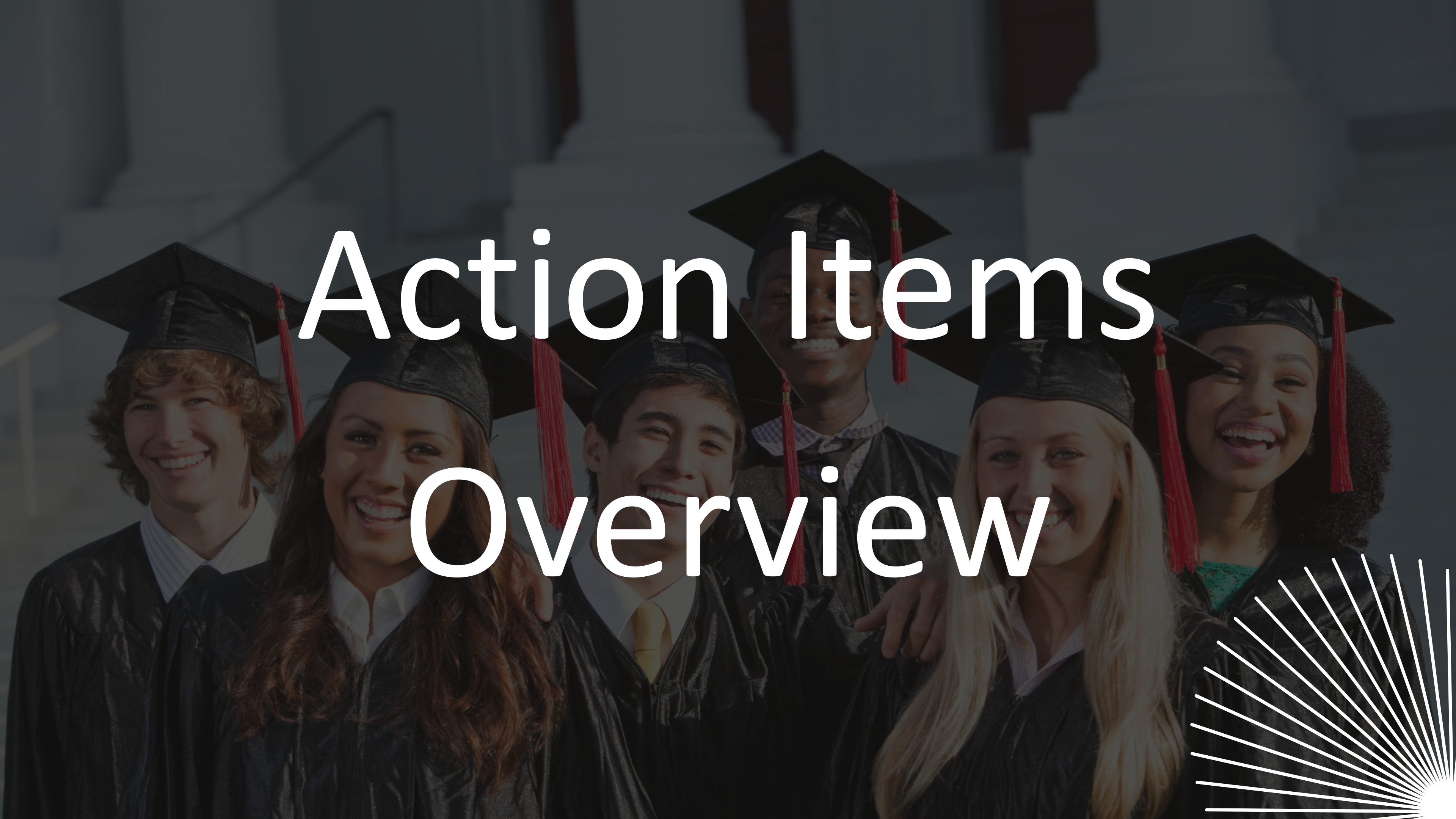

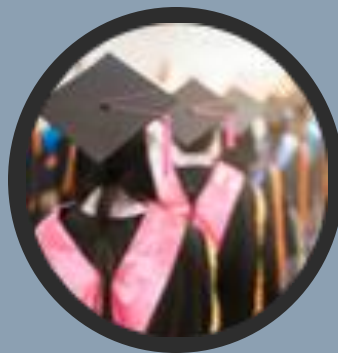
Graduation Items for Pick Up

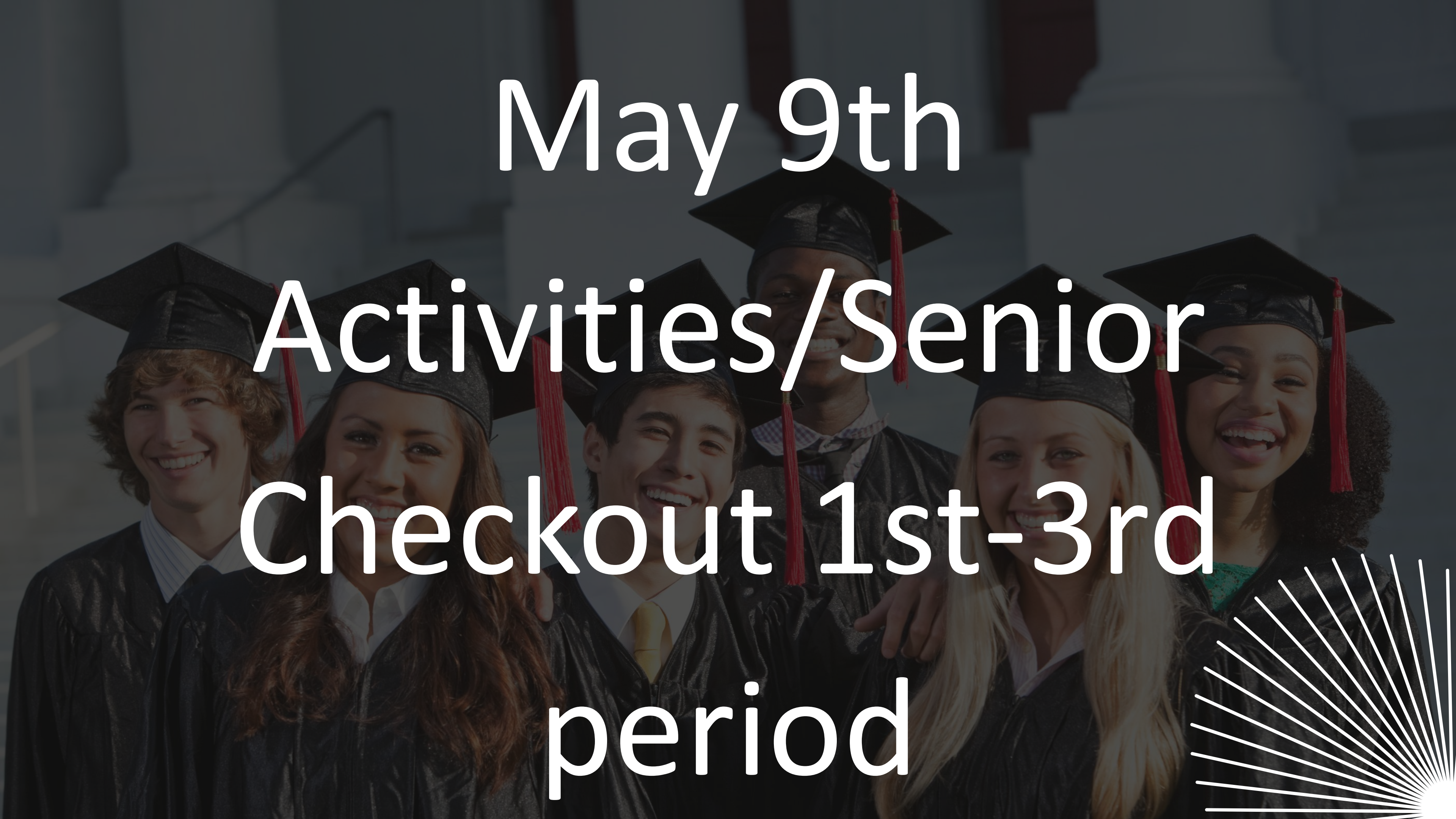


- Senior Only Textbook Drop off will happen in the Hanger during the week of May 5th

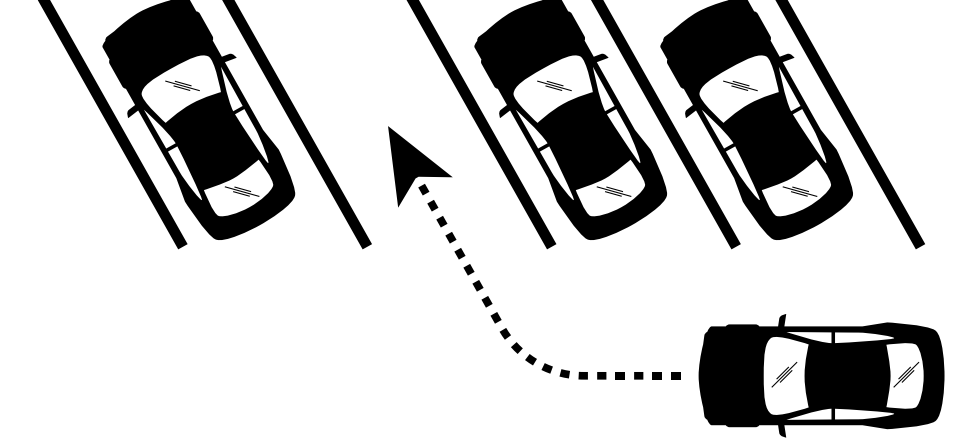

Graduation Practice

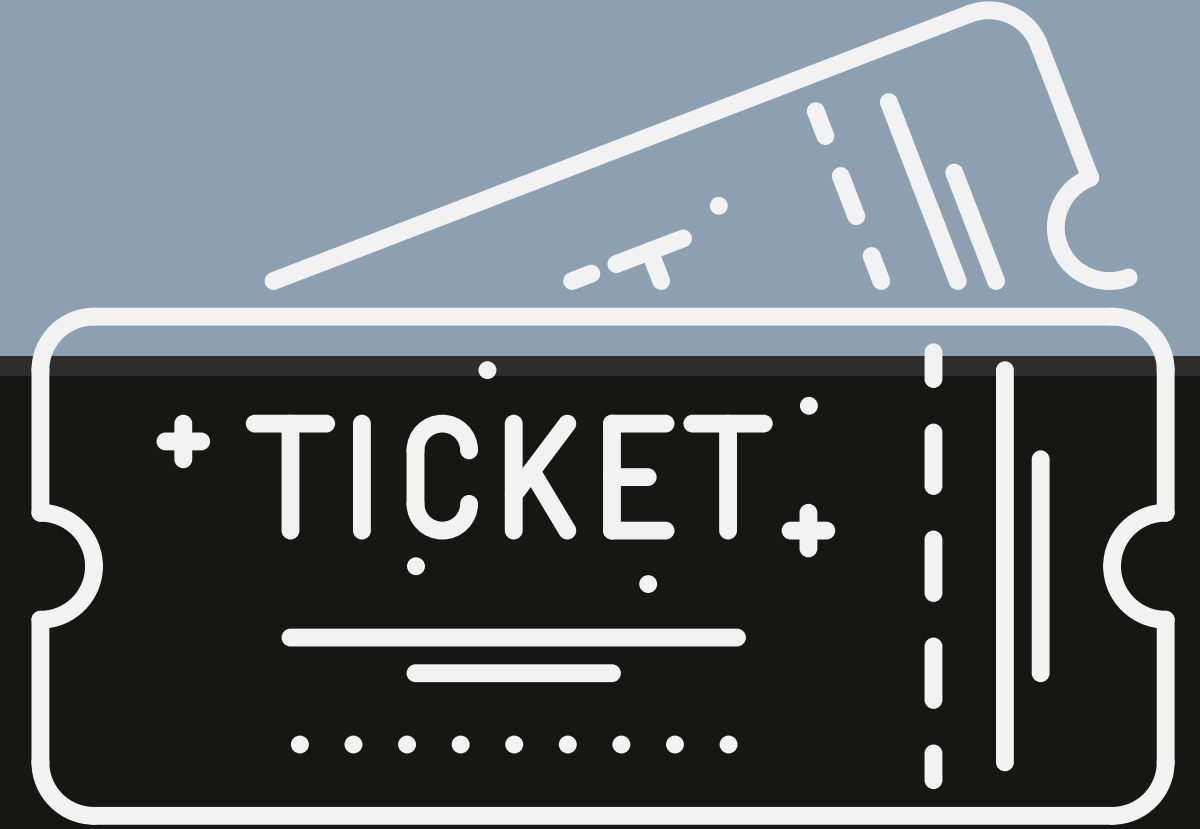
Ameris Amphitheatre, Wednesday May 15, 2025, at 5:30pm.

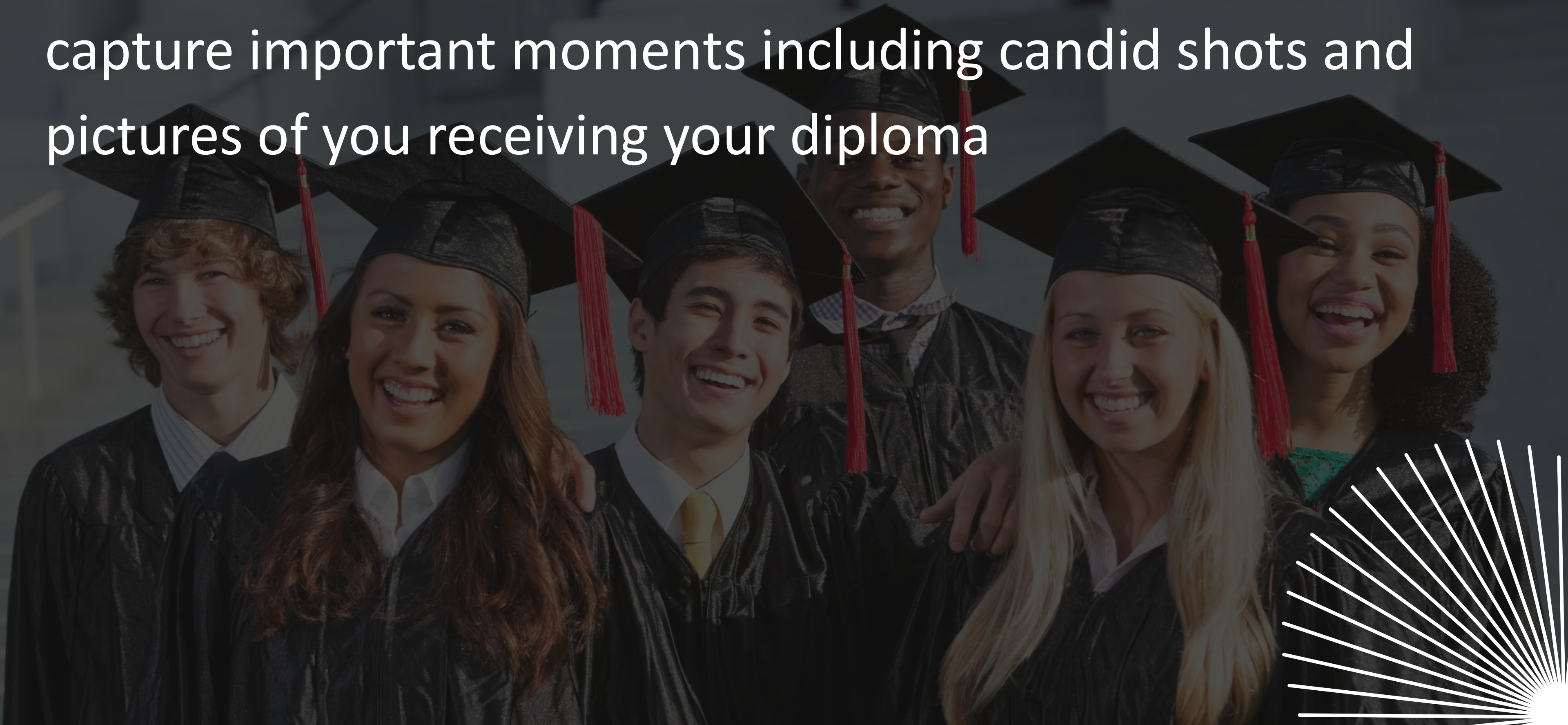


Venue Policy



- Graduation Ceremony:
- Ameris Amphitheatre is a clear bag facility.
- Ameris will allow clear plastic, clear vinyl or clear PVC tote bags no larger than 12" x 6" x 12" and/or small clutch bags (6" x 9").
- In addition to bag checks, Ameris must tag all oversized/diaper bags and camera bags to provide a visual that they have been checked
- Graduates should bring just identification/driver's licenses, car keys, and cell phones (if preferred).
- Concession stands will be open.
- Lawn will be closed.
