STUDENT DEVICE POLICY CHANGES

Fulton County School Board Policy IFBGA (Electronic Communications) has been updated to align with Georgia's "Distraction-Free Education Act."

- **Elementary and Middle School Students** (Grades K-8) are prohibited to use personal devices during the school day.
- High School Students (Grades 9-12) are prohibited to use personal devices during instructional time.
- Not following the rules may result in disciplinary action.
- Students cannot connect their personal devices to school Wi-Fi.

Personal devices are defined as cell phones, smartwatches, laptops, tablets, e-readers, smart glasses, headphones and any device with wireless communication, messaging, internet access, gaming, video recording, or social media features.



UPDATE EMERGENCY CONTACTS

All families are required to log in to the **Infinite Campus Parent Portal** and verify emergency contacts and household information through the "Census Update" feature. This ensures schools can contact you quickly in case of an emergency. Each student must have at least one emergency contact who is not a parent or guardian.
