

Policy IFBGA Electronic Communications

High School (9-12)



To create a safe, focused, and distraction-free environment, all Fulton County high school students (9-12) are prohibited from accessing personal electronic devices during instructional time.

Here is what you need to know:

- Personal devices, including cell phones, smartwatches, laptops, tablets, e-readers, smart glasses, and headphones—or any device with wireless communication, messaging, internet access, gaming, video recording, or social media features—may not be used during instructional time.
- This prohibition applies to instructional time only.
- Using a personal electronic communication device may result in disciplinary action per the FCS Code of Conduct.

This policy aligns with Georgia's new *Distraction-Free Education Act (House Bill 340)* – a law focused on helping students stay focused in school.
