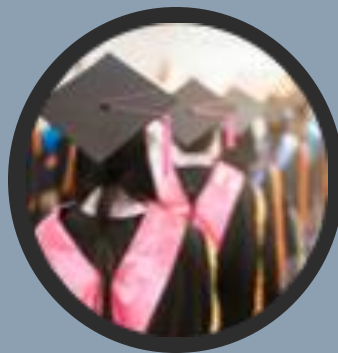




If you have not already done so, pick up your cap and gown and yard sign at the counseling office.

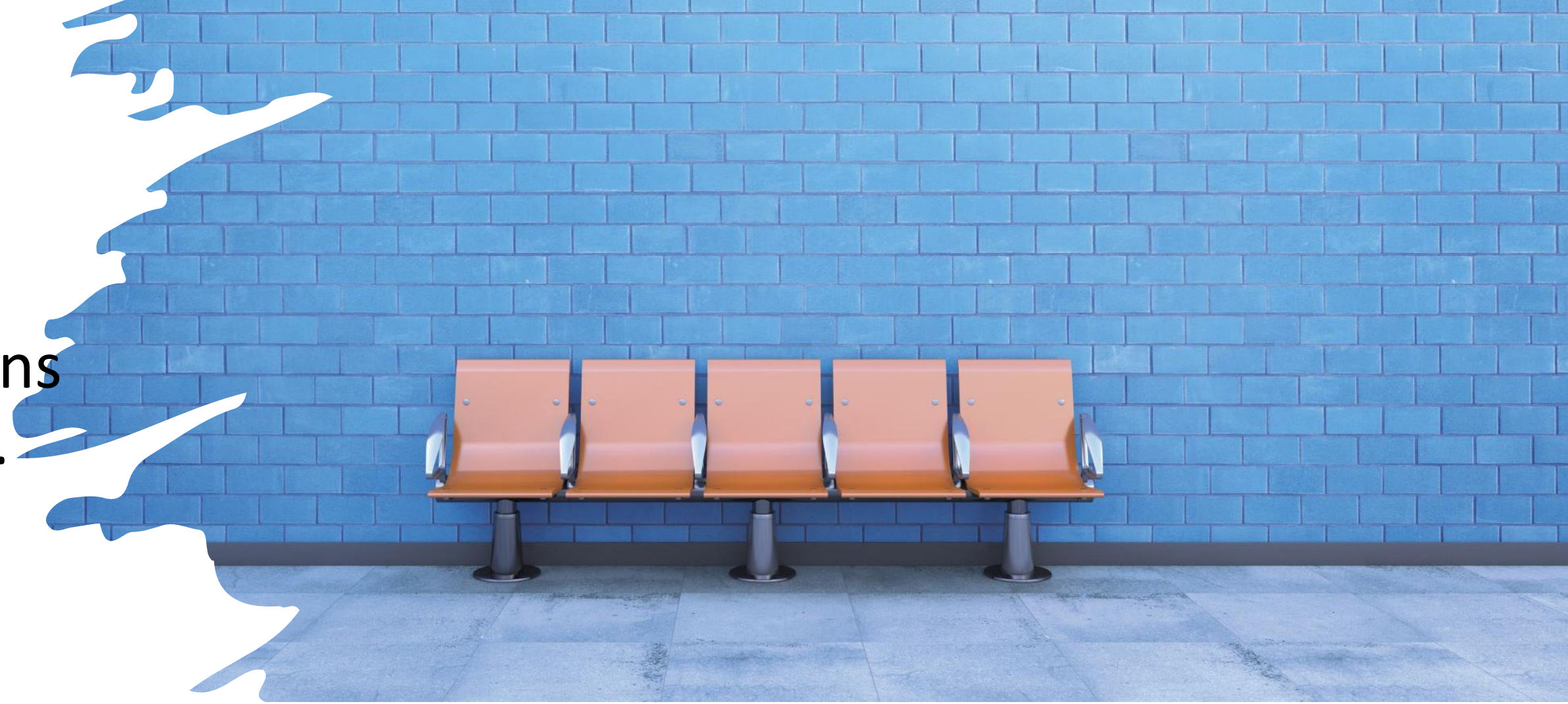

How It Works:

Participating is simple, but meaningful:

Invite family and friends to write cards or letters congratulating your senior.

Have all cards and letters mailed or delivered to your home.

Collect everything into **one large envelope** clearly labeled with your student's **first and last name and student ID**.

Deliver the completed envelope to Innovation Academy during the week of **April 20–24** and place it in the office bins marked “Blue Envelopes.”

Important Guidelines

Do not include money or gifts All items must be no larger than **8.5 x 11 inches**.

Class of 2026 Senior Exit Checklist

What If I Can Not Clear All Items On May 8th?

- Seniors who do not finish their checklist on May 8th can not be cleared for graduation:
 - Keeping Device for AP Exam or Make Up Work
 - Needing to Pay A Fine
 - Etc. Etc.

BUT This is ok!

- **When you are ready to finish your checklist:**
 - Go to Counseling Office
 - Pick Up Checklist Form
 - Do any and all activities and receive signatures on that form
 - Return form back to counseling office
 - This form is how Ms. Lundy knows to clear you for graduation!!!!!!!!!! (not emails, phone calls, etc.)

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS PROTOCOL WILL RESULT IN LARGE DELAYS TO YOU BEING CLEARED

What Is Senior Clearance? How Does It Work?

- **Senior Clearance – manually clearing each student for graduation**
 - Once cleared, you are allowed to pick up your graduation tickets that will be distributed at graduation practice
- **How do I get cleared?**
 - **Academics** – do we have the correct evidence that you have passed all classes needed for graduation?
 - This can mean we are waiting on FVS grades, GAVS grades, In Person Classes, and/or Dual Enrollment transcripts – Screen shots are not allowed!
 - Dual enrollment grades can sometimes be late!
 - **Senior Clearance Items** – computers, fines, textbooks
 - If you have to keep your laptop for an AP exam, you will be cleared once the exam is complete



When does this happen?

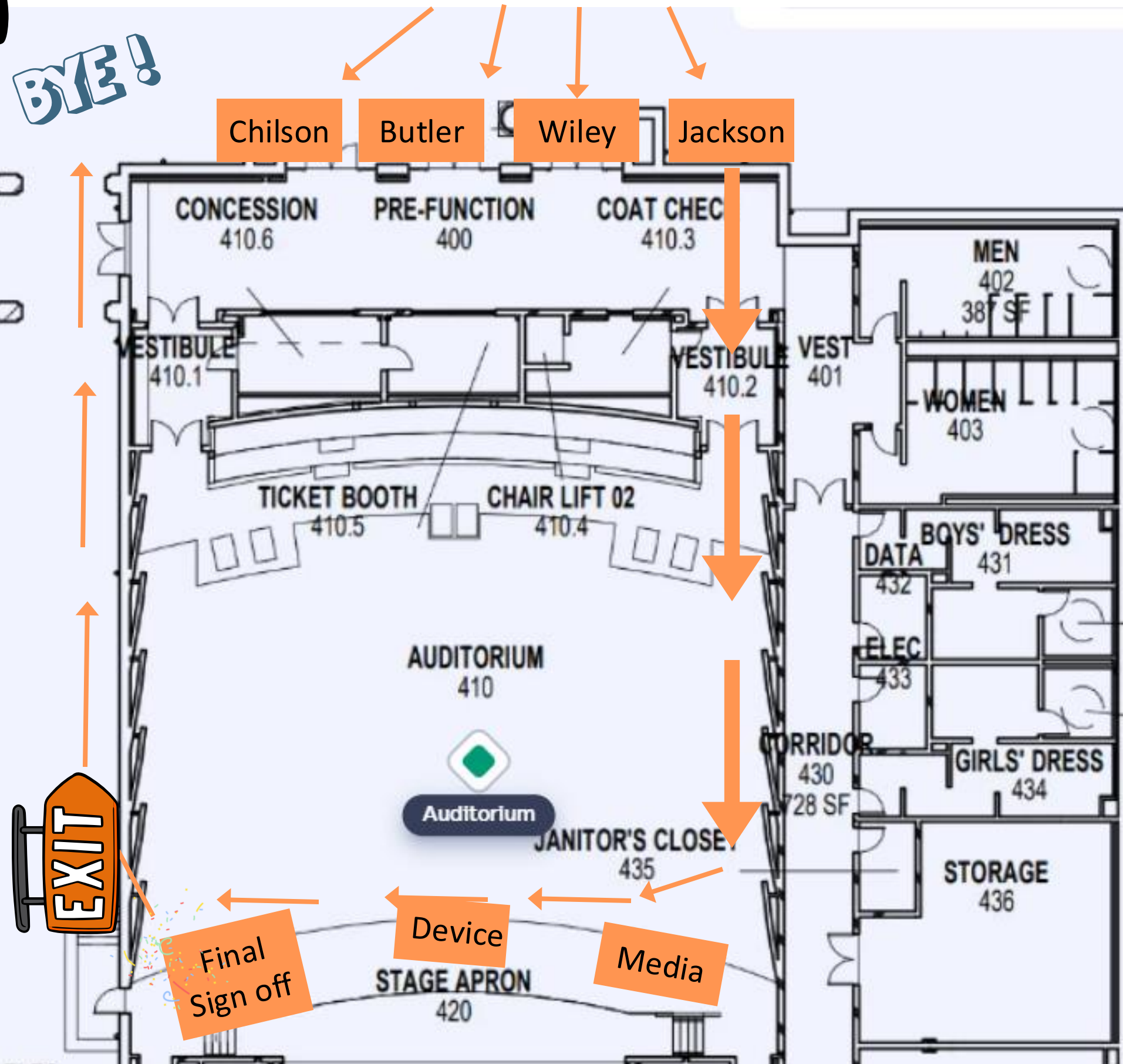
- The first email goes out on Friday, May 8th – usually pretty late after processing all items from the day
- An update is sent everyday until graduation

I am not cleared – I AM FREAKING OUT!

- We have never had a senior not clear. Be patient. Follow all procedures.
 - Example: Don't drop your computer off to a random person – follow protocol!!

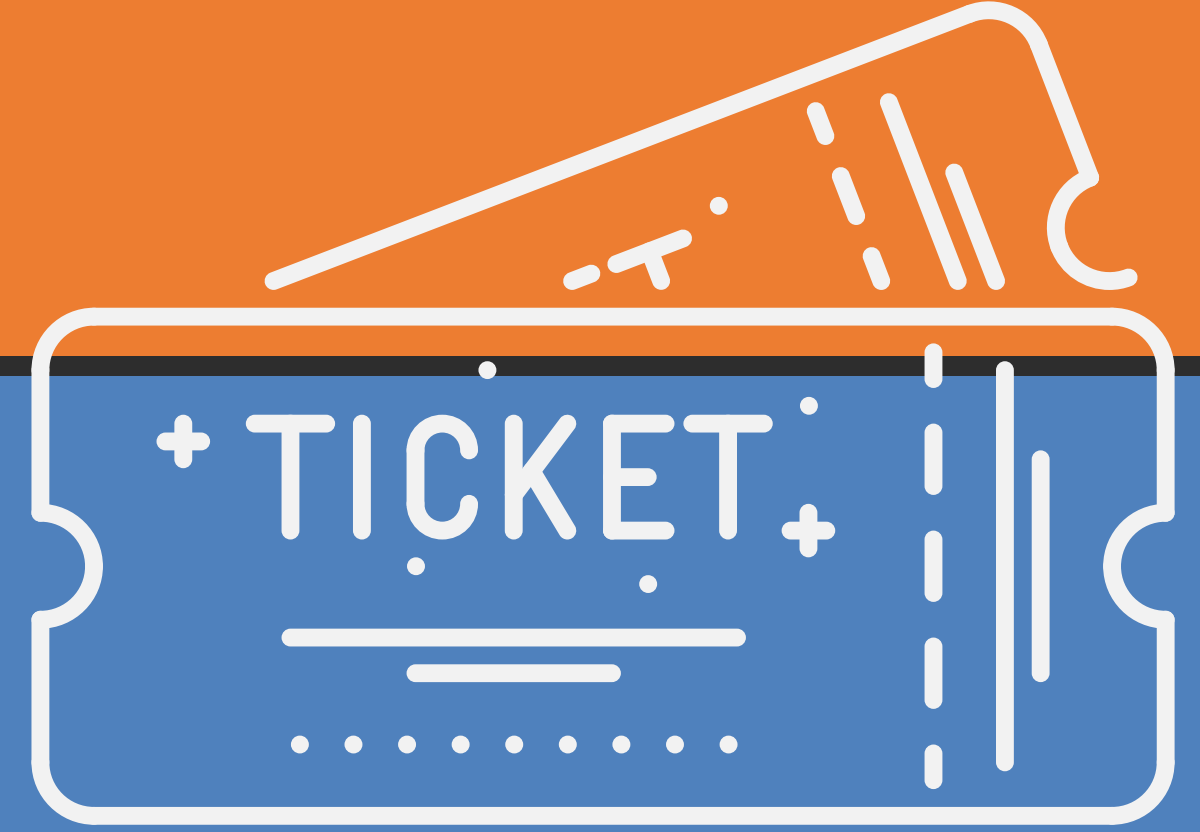
- Arrive no later than 2:45pm.

Graduation Practice:

- We will distribute tickets at practice
- Each graduating senior will receive 10 tickets!
- Additional purchased tickets will be included in your envelope
- Before receiving your tickets, you must be cleared of any outstanding school fines and have completed the Senior Checkout

Graduation Ceremony:

- Each individual attending will be required to have their own ticket with the exception of:
 - Graduating seniors
 - Toddlers not occupying their own seat

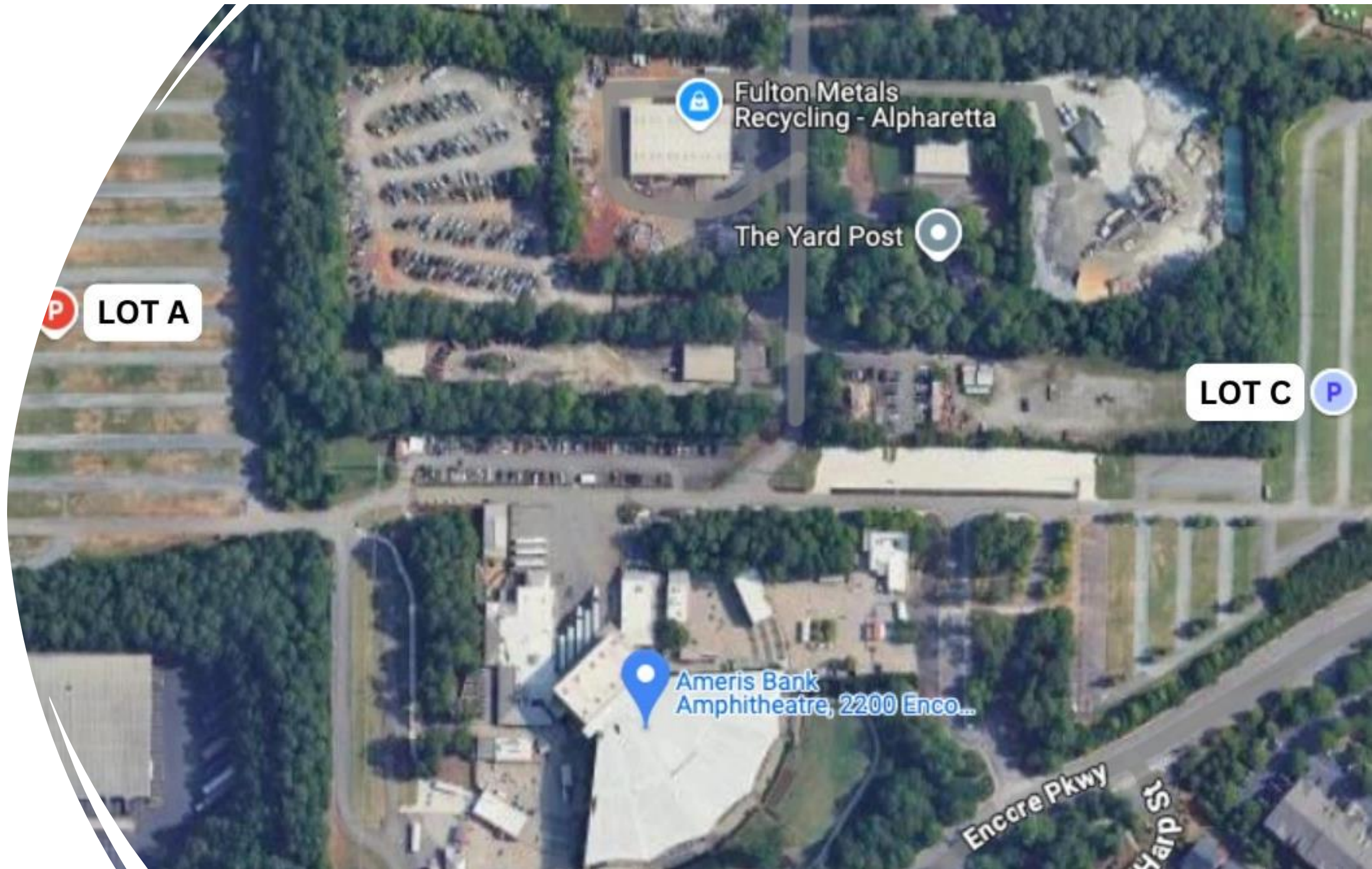


Graduation Ceremony

Parking

- **Students park in LOT C:**
- 11450 Maxwell Rd, Alpharetta, GA 30009
- Graduates should arrive no later than 11:30a.m. in their cap and gown.
- Don't bring purses, backpacks, change of shoes.

- **Parents park in LOT A:**
- 1775 Founders Parkway, Alpharetta, GA 30009
- Gates open at 12pm



Dress Code

- Dressy attire with cap & gown. **Make sure you wear attire that blends with the gown (see picture)**
- Avoid sandals, flip flops, hiking boots, or tennis shoes.
- Gowns and caps may not be modified or altered in any way.
- All regalia (cords and pins), must be approved and provided through the sponsor of a school-approved organization.



Venue Policy

- Ameris Amphitheatre is a clear bag facility.
- Ameris will allow clear plastic, clear vinyl or clear PVC tote bags no larger than 12" x 6" x 12" and/or small clutch bags (6" x 9").
- In addition to bag checks, Ameris must tag all oversized/diaper bags and camera bags to provide a visual that they have been checked
- Graduates should bring just identification/driver's licenses, car keys, and cell phones (if preferred).
- Concession stands will be open.
- Lawn will be closed.
